ORDER

The Office of Export Enforcement, Bureau of Export Administration, United States Department of Commerce (BXA), having notified Hua Ko Electronics Co. Ltd. (Hua Ko) of its intention to initiate an administrative proceeding against Hua Ko pursuant to Section 13(c) of the Export Administration Act of 1979, as amended (50 U.S.C.A. app. §§ 2401-2420 (1991 & Supp. 1999)) (the Act),¹ and the Export Administration Regulations (currently codified at

Parts 730-774 (1999)) (the Regulations),² based on allegations that, from on or about August 5, 1994 through on or about December 20, 1996, Hua Ko, a person denied all U.S. export privileges by an Order dated November 30, 1989 (hereinafter referred to as the 1989 Order), ordered and received commodities exported from the United States, contrary to the terms of the 1989 Order denying its export, in violation of Section 787.6 (redesignated as Section 787A.6 on March 25, 1996) of the former Regulations and that, from on or about January 3, 1997 through October 9, 1997, Hua Ko, a person denied all U.S. export privileges by the 1989 Order, ordered and received commodities exported from the United States, contrary to the terms of the 1989 Order denying its export privileges, in violation of Section 764.2(a) of the Regulations; and

BXA and Hua Ko having entered into a Settlement Agreement pursuant to Section 766.18(b) of the Regulations whereby they agreed to settle this matter in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth therein, and the terms of the Settlement Agreement having been approved by me;

The former Regulations and the Regulations define the various violations that BXA alleges occurred. The Regulations establish the procedures that apply to this matter.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

FIRST, that a civil penalty of \$174,000 is assessed against Hua Ko, \$87,000 of which shall be paid to the U. S. Department of Commerce within 30 days from the date of this Order. Payment of the remaining \$87,000 shall be suspended for a period of one year from the date of the entry of the appropriate Order and shall thereafter waived, provided that, during the period of suspension, Hua Ko has committed no violation of the Act, or any regulation, order, or license issued thereunder. Payment shall be made in the manner specified in the attached instructions.

SECOND, that, pursuant to the Debt Collection Act of 1982, as amended (31 U.S.C.A. §§ 3701-3720E (1983 and Supp. 1999)), the civil penalty owed under this Order accrues interest as more fully described in the attached Notice, and, if payment is not made by the due date specified herein, Hua Ko will be assessed, in addition to interest, a penalty charge and an administrative charge, as more fully described in the attached Notice.

THIRD, Hua Ko, 9 Dai Shun Street, Tai Po Ind. Estate, Tai Po, New Territories, Hong Kong, and all of its successors and assigns, officers, representatives, agents, and employees, may not, for a period of five years from November 29, 2004, participate, directly or indirectly, in any way in any transaction involving any commodity, software, or technology (hereinafter collectively referred to as "item") exported or to be exported from the United States that is subject to the Regulations, or in any other activity subject to the Regulations, including, but not limited to:

- A. Applying for, obtaining, or using any license, License Exception, or export control document;

- B. Carrying on negotiations concerning, or ordering, buying, receiving, using, selling, delivering, storing, disposing of, forwarding, transporting, financing, or otherwise servicing in any way, any transaction involving any item exported or to be exported from the United States that is subject to the Regulations, or in any other activity subject to the Regulations; or
- C. Benefiting in any way from any transaction involving any item exported or to be exported from the United States that is subject to the Regulations, or in any other activity subject to the Regulations.

FOURTH, that no person may, directly or indirectly, do any of the following:

- A. Export or reexport to or on behalf of the denied person any item subject to the Regulations;
- B. Take any action that facilitates the acquisition or attempted acquisition by a denied person of the ownership, possession, or control of any item subject to the Regulations that has been or will be exported from the United States, including financing or other support activities related to a transaction whereby a denied person acquires or attempts to acquire such ownership, possession or control;
- C. Take any action to acquire from or to facilitate the acquisition or attempted acquisition from the denied person of any item subject to the Regulations that has been exported from the United States;
- D. Obtain from the denied person in the United States any item subject to the Regulations with knowledge or reason to know that the item will be, or is intended to be, exported from the United States; or

E. Engage in any transaction to service any item subject to the Regulations that has been or will be exported from the United States that is owned, possessed or controlled by a denied person, or service any item, of whatever origin, that is owned, possessed or controlled by a denied person if such service involves the use of any item subject to the Regulations that has been or will be exported from the United States. For purposes of this paragraph, servicing means installation, maintenance, repair, modification or testing.

FIFTH, that, after notice and opportunity for comment as provided in Section 766.23 of the Regulations, any person, firm, corporation, or business organization related to the denied person by affiliation, ownership, control, or position of responsibility in the conduct of trade or related services may also be made subject to the provisions of this Order.

SIXTH, that as authorized by Section 766.18(c) of the Regulations, the five-year denial period set forth in paragraph THIRD above shall be suspended in its entirety for five years from November 29, 2004, and shall thereafter be waived, provided that, during the period of suspension, Hua Ko has committed no violation of the Act or any regulation, order or license issued thereunder.

SEVENTH, that the proposed Charging Letter, Settlement Agreement, and this Order shall be made available to the public.

This Order, which constitutes the final agency action in this matter, is effective immediately.

SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

This Agreement is made by and between Hua Ko Electronics Co. Ltd. (Hua Ko) and the Bureau of Export Administration, United States Department of Commerce, pursuant to Section 766.18(a) of the Export Administration Regulations (currently codified at 15 C.F.R. Parts 730-774 (1999)) (the Regulations),¹ issued pursuant to the Export Administration Act of

Whereas, the Office of Export Enforcement, Bureau of Export Administration (BXA), has notified Hua Ko of its intention to initiate an administrative proceeding against Hua Ko pursuant to the Act and the Regulations, based on allegations that, from on or about August 5, 1994 through on or about December 20, 1996, Hua Ko, a person denied all U.S. export privileges by an Order dated November 29, 1989 (hereinafter referred to as the 1989 Order), ordered and received commodities exported from the United States, contrary to the terms of the 1989 Order denying its export privileges, in violation of Section 787.6 (redesignated as Section 787A.6 on March 25, 1996) of the former Regulations, and that, from on or about January 3, 1997 through October 9, 1997, Hua Ko, a person denied all U.S. export privileges by the 1989 Order, ordered and received commodities exported from the United States, contrary to the terms of the Order denying its export privileges, in violation of Section 764.2(a) of the Regulations;

Whereas, Hua Ko has reviewed the proposed Charging Letter and is aware of the allegations made against it and the administrative sanctions which could be imposed against it if the allegations are found to be true; it fully understands the terms of this Settlement Agreement and the Order; it enters into this Settlement Agreement voluntarily and with full

knowledge of its rights, and it states that no promises or representations have been made to it other than the agreements and considerations herein expressed;

Whereas, Hua Ko neither admits nor denies the allegations contained in the proposed Charging Letter;

Whereas, Hua Ko wishes to settle and dispose of all matters alleged in the proposed Charging Letter by entering into this Settlement Agreement; and

Whereas, Hua Ko agrees to be bound by an appropriate Order giving effect to the terms of this Settlement Agreement, when entered (appropriate Order);

Now Therefore, Hua Ko and BXA agree as follows:

1. BXA has jurisdiction over Hua Ko, under the Act and the Regulations, in connection with the matters alleged in the proposed Charging Letter.
2. BXA and Hua Ko agree that the following sanctions shall be imposed against Hua Ko in complete settlement of all alleged violations of the Act, the former Regulations and the Regulations set forth in the proposed Charging Letter:

- (a) Hua Ko shall be assessed a civil penalty of \$174,000, \$87,000 of which shall be paid to the U.S. Department of Commerce within 30 days from the date of entry of an appropriate Order. Payment of the remaining \$87,000 shall be suspended for a period of one year from the date of the entry of the appropriate Order and shall thereafter be waived, provided that, during the period of suspension, Hua Ko has committed no violation of the Act, or any regulation, order, or license issued thereunder;

- (b) Hua Ko and all of its successors and assigns, officers, representatives, agents, and employees, may not, for a period of five years from November 29, 2004, participate, directly or indirectly, in any way in any transaction involving any commodity, software or technology (hereinafter collectively referred to as "item") exported or to be exported from the United States that is subject to the Regulations, or in any other activity subject to the Regulations, including, but not limited to:
- i. Applying for, obtaining, or using any license, License Exception, or export control document;
 - ii. Carrying on negotiations concerning, or ordering, buying, receiving, using, selling, delivering, storing, disposing of, forwarding, transporting, financing, or otherwise servicing in any way, any transaction involving any item exported or to be exported from the United States that is subject to the Regulations, or in any other activity subject to the Regulations; or
 - iii. Benefitting in any way from any transaction involving any item exported or to be exported from the United States that is subject to the Regulations, or in any other activity subject to the Regulations.

- (c) BXA agrees that, as authorized by Section 766.18(c) of the Regulations, the five year denial period set forth in paragraph 2(b) shall be suspended for a period of five years from November 29, 2004 and shall thereafter be waived, provided that during the period of

suspension, Hua Ko has committed no violation of the Act or any regulation, order or license issued thereunder.

3. Hua Ko agrees that, subject to the approval of this Settlement Agreement pursuant to paragraph 8 hereof, it hereby waives all rights to further procedural steps in this matter (except with respect to any alleged violation of this Settlement Agreement or the appropriate Order, when entered), including, without limitation, any right: (a) to an administrative hearing regarding the allegations in the proposed Charging Letter; (b) to request a refund of the civil penalty imposed pursuant to this Settlement Agreement and the appropriate Order, when entered; and (c) to seek judicial review or otherwise to contest the validity of this Settlement Agreement or the appropriate Order, when entered.

4. BXA agrees that, upon entry of an appropriate Order, it will not initiate any further administrative proceedings against Hua Ko in connection with any violations of the Act or the Regulations arising out of the transactions identified in the proposed Charging Letter.

5. Hua Ko understands that BXA will make the proposed Charging Letter, this Settlement Agreement and the appropriate Order, when entered, available to the public.

6. BXA and Hua Ko agree that this Settlement Agreement is for settlement purposes only. Therefore, if this Settlement Agreement is not accepted and an appropriate Order is not issued by the Assistant Secretary for Export Enforcement pursuant to Section 766.18(a) of the Regulations, BXA and Hua Ko agree that they may not use this Settlement Agreement in any administrative or judicial proceeding and that neither party shall be bound by the terms contained in this Settlement Agreement in any subsequent administrative or judicial proceeding.

7. No agreement, understanding, representation or interpretation not contained in this Settlement Agreement may be used to vary or otherwise affect the terms of this Settlement Agreement or the appropriate Order, when entered, nor shall this Settlement Agreement serve to bind, constrain, or otherwise limit any action by any other agency or department of the United States Government with respect to the facts and circumstances addressed herein.

8. This Settlement Agreement shall become binding on BXA only when the Assistant Secretary for Export Enforcement approves it by entering an appropriate Order, which will have the same force and effect as a decision and order issued after a full administrative hearing on the record.

Dear Mr. Zhu:

The Office of Export Enforcement, Bureau of Export Administration, United States Department of Commerce (BXA), hereby charges that, as described in detail below, Hua Ko Electronics Co. Ltd. (Hua Ko) has violated the Export Administration Regulations (currently codified at 15 C.F.R. Parts 730-774 (1999)) (the Regulations),¹ issued pursuant to the Export Administration Act of 1979, as amended (50 U.S.C.A. app. §§ 2401-2420 (1991 & Supp. 1999)) (the Act).²

Facts constituting violations:

Charges 1-132

As is described in greater detail in Schedule A, which is enclosed herewith and incorporated herein by reference, from on or about August 5, 1994 through on or about December 20, 1996, Hua Ko, a person denied all U. S . export privileges by Order dated November 29, 1989 (hereinafter referred to as the 1989 Order), ordered and received commodities exported from the United States. Hua Ko's involvement in these transactions was contrary to the terms of the 1989 Order denying its export privileges. BXA alleges that, by ordering and receiving any commodity exported from the United States in violation of or contrary to any provision of the Act or any regulation, order or license issued thereunder, Hua Ko committed 88 violations of Section 787.6 and 44 violations of Section 787A.6 of the former Regulations in connection with each of the shipments, for a total of 132 violations.

Charges 133-174

As is described in greater detail in Schedule A, which is enclosed herewith and incorporated herein by reference, from on or about January 3, 1997 through on or about October 9, 1997, Hua Ko, a person denied all U.S. export privileges by the 1989 Order, ordered and received commodities exported from the United States. Hua Ko's involvement in these transactions was contrary to the terms of the 1989 Order denying its export privileges. BXA alleges that, by engaging in conduct prohibited by or contrary to the Act, the Regulations, or any order, license or authorization issued thereunder, Hua Ko violated Section 764.2(a) of the Regulations in connection with each of the shipments, for a total of 42 violations.

BXA alleges that Hua Ko committed 88 violations of Section 787.6 of the former Regulations, 44 violations of Section 787A.6 of the former Regulations, and 42 violations of Section 764.2(a) of the Regulations, for a total of 174 violations.

Accordingly, Hua Ko is hereby notified that an administrative proceeding is instituted against it pursuant to Section 13(c) of the Act and Part 766 of the Regulations for the purpose of obtaining an order imposing administrative sanctions, including any or all of the following:

The maximum civil penalty allowed by law of \$10,000 per violation (see Section 764.3(a)(1) of the Regulations);³

Denial of export privileges (see Section 764.3(a)(2) of the Regulations); and/or

Exclusion from practice before BXA (see Section 764.3(a)(3) of the Regulations).

Copies of relevant Parts of the Regulations are enclosed.

If Hua Ko fails to answer the charges contained in this letter within 30 days after being served with notice of issuance of this letter as provided in Section 766.6 of the Regulations, that failure will be treated as a default under Section 766.7.

Hua Ko is further notified that it is entitled to an agency hearing on the record as provided by Section 13(c) of the Act and Section 766.6 of the Regulations, if a written demand for one is filed with its answer, to be represented by counsel, and to seek a consent settlement.

Pursuant to an Interagency Agreement between BXA and the U.S. Coast Guard, the U.S. Coast Guard is providing administrative law judge services, to the extent that such services are required under the Regulations, in connection with the matters set forth in this letter.

Accordingly, Hua Ko's answer should be filed with the U.S. Coast Guard ALJ Docketing Center, 40 S. Gay Street, Baltimore, Maryland 21202-4022, in accordance with the instructions in Section 766.5(a) of the Regulations. In addition, a copy of Hua Ko's answer should be served on BXA at the address set forth in Section 766.5(b), adding "ATTENTION: Mi-Yong Kim, Esq." below the address.
